History

The optimists, Inc was incorporated with the State of New York as a not for profit corporation on October 6, 2000. The organization has received tax exempt status from Internal Revenue Service under section 501 ©(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. It has offices in Bangladesh and is registered with N.G.O. Bureau.

Basis for accounting

As a not for profit corporation, The Optimists, Inc. has adopted cash basis as the basis for recording and reporting financial data. All cash received and payments made are reflected in the books and financial statements. Statement of receipts and payments and statement of fund balance are prepared to reflect the operating result of the corporation.

Operating objective:

The primary purpose of the organization is to channel funds of the donors to children of the needy families of Bangladesh in the form of sponsorship payments provided to them by individual sponsors in USA. Sponsorship is open to all persons living in North America and is not restricted to Bangladeshi immigrants. Besides, anyone from any country can contribute to Child sponsorship Program.

Organizational expenses:

The management of Optimists, Inc. is run on a voluntary basis. No compensation is received by any of the office bearers. Though currently, there is no salary expenses incurred by the organization, in future, as the sponsorship program grows, expenditure for clerical services may be incurred.

Property and equipment

The organization does not have any asset, all office furniture are donated and the corporate office is leased furnished. Currently it does not have any depreciation policy.

Bangladesh Activities

Primary operating activities are conducted by the organization in Bangladesh under the supervision of the Country Director.
